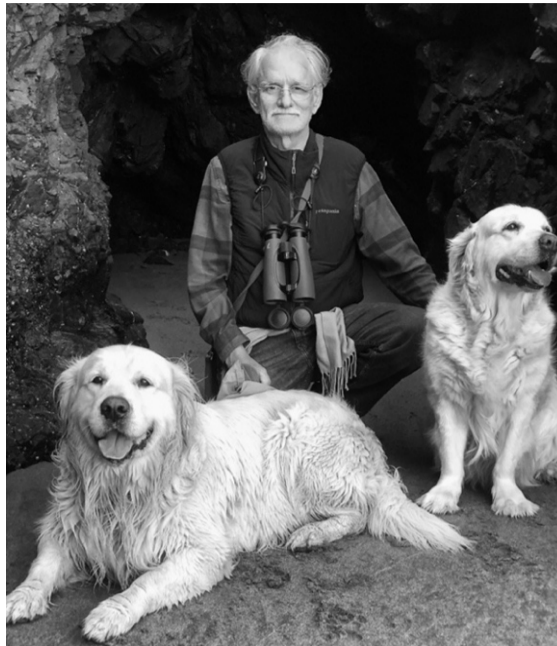


MANUEL ALONSO-MARTINEZ
